
The Bookeye 4 is the first book scanner to come with its own 7.2 inch touchscreen and a PC equipped with a dual core 1.8GHz processer, 2GBytes of DRAM and a 1GBit network connection.

The Bookeye 4 is a complete solution -- ready to scan even if only the very affordable base model is purchased. Unlike nearly all competing scanners, customers purchasing the Bookeye 4 will incur no additional costs for external PCs, monitors or additional software.



The 7.2 inch touchscreen provides access to all functions directly from the scanner. It is very easy to access and is operator-friendly because it is located right at the center of the scanner, where the operator is.

Other scanner vendors have varying degrees of machine control but almost all of them locate these at the rightmost perimeter of their scanners, not ergonomically ideal.

Running it's own PC has many advantages. Other scanners have to specify the PC being used with respect to speed, memory, operating system and other factors before they can specify scanning speeds, maximum scanning width and length. The Bookeye 4 is different. Whether you scan via the build in touchscreen, via a TWAIN enabled software or even with a browser enabled cell phone, scanning performance does not differ at all.

The Bookeye 4 is a true network scanner and installs very easily into today's office infrastructure. The scanner does not need any driver software or interface to be installed; it is ready to operate through the Scan2Net interface the minute you have assigned it a valid IP address.
